



CWCN Holiday Activities—Spring 2021

Thursday, 23rd September 2021 *Budding Birders Bonanza*

What better way to spend a morning than by having fun and learning about birds at the same time. Lots to do too. We'll check out who interfered with 'eggs' in little nests placed in shrubs and trees and on the ground. We use binoculars to observe waterfowl, tick boxes on our bird finder pamphlet to see which birds visit the park, and figure out who has the best spotter's eyes. We learn (by using 'beaks') why birds have different beak shapes and what those different shapes are used for. Finally, we compare different bird feet and whether they have anything to do with habitat. If we still have time, we may even create our very own beak.

And to make it an even better experience, sing along to Judy's accordion and any ukulele you may want to bring along. Wear something warm, it may still be cool. Wear long pants and closed shoes. Don't forget your torch. Why not have a little snooze in the afternoon because we finish after bedtime for some.

Thursday, 30th September 2021 *All plants small and tall. A fun exploration of the natural world.*

Our plant detectives look at everything from roots to stems. leaves, flowers and seeds. They learn about tiny plants and about very tall ones. They learn about how long plants live, and how their age can be measured. They explore how they grow and where, and whether all of them grow in soil. And there are questions about what they might do in winter or during a drought, whether all plants are good. Of course, our detectives will need to find out whether plants are important, and if so, why and for whom? Hands on fun explorations around the CWCN Centre are on the agenda.
