Enviro Detectives Roaring Rhonda and William Whisper Investigate Sound. How it comes about, what it does, and when it is too much

Lots to find out. How is sound made? Why does an elephant sound different to a cicada? How do our ears work? How is sound transported? This is going to be fun! We make different sounds, we figure it all out using balloons, water, strings, stethoscopes, tuning forks, ear muffs and much more. We measure our sound and see how sound can make things move. We also learn what to avoid to protect our hearing and when sound levels become unhealthy.

Let's go Fungi Hunting!

This exciting morning will start with an introduction to the Fungi Kingdom (fungi are much more than mushrooms). We learn what they are, what they do, and how they fit into the big scheme of all things in the environment. Then it's all about discovery. We'll be outdoors all morning and work with magnifying glasses and mirrors, take notes, draw pictures and use a chart to group the fungi we find according to their shape (some we may be able to identify) and will also try to figure out whether they recycle dead organic matter, help plants grow, or destroy a tree. This is a hands-on workshop full of detection. Keen budding scientists wanted!

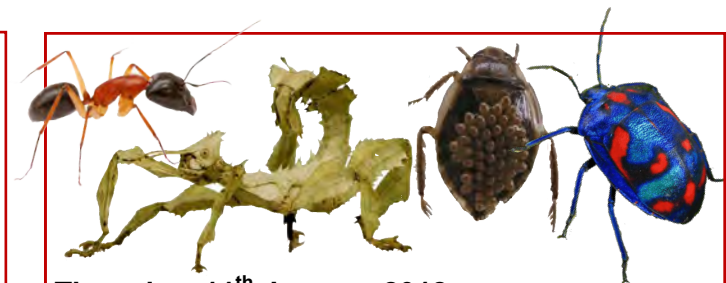

Catching Critters—the tiny ones

Off we go equipped with butterfly, dip and sweep nets, pitfall traps, pooters, magnifiers and so forth. Let's see what we find and whether we can figure out what your catch is. This is a very varied activity and includes small and larger vegetation and also the local creek, because critters exist in abundance outside of and in water and can tell us a lot about healthy conditions. A hands on pursuit, for all budding entomologists. BYO hat and water bottle, wear protective clothing and sturdy closed shoes and if you have bring gum boots along. We'll bring the equipment, the sunscreen, the insect repellent, and the morning tea for hungry critter catchers.
